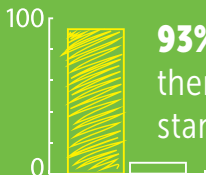
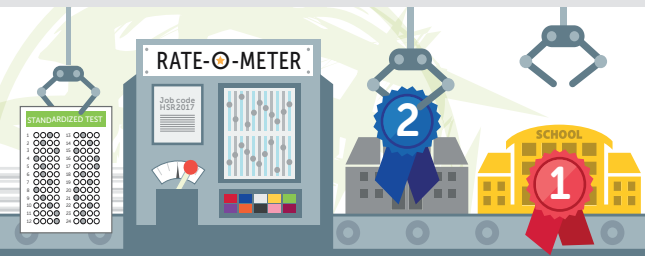


INCOMPLETE PICTURE

The ATA **opposes** the use of standardized tests to compare and rank schools. A recent public opinion poll of 800 randomly selected Albertans shows support for this view.
