The ATA Library is your information source for professional development needs.

Teachers can access e-books, streaming video, three databases of articles and reports, as well as a collection of librarian-approved sites through our home page. Through our library catalogue, educators can request maker technology kits, DVDs, journal articles, reports, and books that will be delivered to your school or home.

All shipments include **pre-paid return postage** so there is no cost for borrowing materials no matter where you live in the province.

Our Library Catalogue

To request materials, login to our library homepage (<http://library.teachers.ab.ca>) using your ATA online account. The Log In link is in the upper right-hand corner of our site.

Use the Search the Library box, select your titles, and click the request button to send an email request to our library staff for the titles that you are interested in borrowing. A pop-up box should appear with your email address listed (if it does not appear, please allow pop-ups for our site and click

the request button again). Add your name to the box and press OK. You will get a confirmation email in your inbox.

Our staff will mail out the materials immediately unless they are on loan to another teacher.

Loan Periods

All materials are loaned for 28 day periods. Loans can be extended if the materials have not been requested by another ATA member.
