Our Library Catalogue

To request materials, login to our library homepage (http://library.teachers.ab.ca) using your ATA online account. The **Log In** link is in the upper right-hand corner of our site.

Use the **Search the Library** box, select your titles, and click the request button to send an email request to our library staff for the titles that you are interested in borrowing. A pop-up box should appear with your email address listed (if it does not appear, please allow pop-ups for our site and click the request button again). Add your name to the box and press OK. You will get a confirmation email in your inbox.

Loan Periods

All materials are loaned for **28 day** periods. Loans can be extended if another ATA Member has not requested the material. Please always return materials promptly as teachers may need the materials to support their practice.
